




More about *Dancing at Lughnasa --* Brian Friel's powerful memory play:

## **Cherry Blossom Theatre Festival set for March 9-11**



#### 3 days. 5 workshops. 6 venues. 15 performances. All in Salem!

The <u>Salem Theatre Network</u> will hold its second annual Cherry Blossom Theatre Festival March 9 through 11 in Salem.

The three-day event features 15 performances and five workshops in six venues across the city.

The Cherry Blossom Theatre Festival has something for everyone: from fully staged performances to staged readings to a Spanish-language play to improvisational comedy

to educational workshops.

The event has two tracks – <u>All Access</u> at \$65 and <u>General Admission</u> at \$35. The network is also offering a <u>discounted General Admission pass at \$25</u> for students and for individuals who hold an Oregon Trail card.

Patrons who purchase the All Access pass will be able to attend Pentacle Theatre's production of *Calendar Girls* and a performance of <u>Enlightened Theatrics'</u> *The Foreigner* and choose from among any of the other events on the three-day schedule.

Proceeds from ticket sales will fund the network's Young Audience Opportunity Grant, which supports middle school children's awareness of and appreciation for live theater. The grant funds transportation from middle schools in the Salem/Keizer, Silverton and Aumsville districts to high-school theater performances.
